2017 Capturing the Garden Photography Competition

Prospectus

Summary. The purpose of this prospectus is to encourage fellow gardeners as well as visitors of the 2017 Samuel P. Capen Garden Walk to submit at least one photograph of any garden in the garden walk (or their own garden) for consideration in the "Capturing the Garden" exhibition. The University Heights Arts Association will produce and jury the competition for a \$30. prize. Participants will be included as part of the "Capturing the Garden" exhibition that will be held in September at Amy's Place Restaurant and Queen City Imaging as part of the UHAA ARTpartnering Program.

Guidelines. Amateur and professional photographers alike may photograph anything from a single flower to an entire garden. Only photographs of the artist's own garden or of the 2016 Samuel P. Capen Garden Walk are eligible. Work must be original and creative. The photograph(s) submitted must be printed by the time of the exhibition. Copyrighted images not owned by the artist will not be accepted.

Size. Email digital images for jurying. The final (printed) photo must be 300 dpi at 10 united inches or larger print size (6 in. + 4 in. = 10 united inches as does 5 in. x 5 in.). Exhibition. For the exhibition, work must be ready to hang and framed (no sawtooth hangers).

Number of Entries. Each artist may submit up to 10 total works.
Eligibility. This exhibit is open to:
1) members, partners and supporters of the UHAA
2) members of the University District and surrounding communities
3) interested artists from anywhere

Prizes. A \$30. prize as well as wide area recognition is waiting for the winner.
Sales and Display of Works. The exhibition will take place from Sept.13-Oct. 11, 2017. UHAA members also wishing to sell work submitted to this competition may choose to have it listed in the UHAA ONLINE STORE. (UHAA membership is \$10. per year and includes the use of our online store as well as a member web page.)

Entry Fee. Free.
